01/18	ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIRMAN Cllr Samme advised that she would like to share the role of chair with Cllr Dearing – proposed Cllr Champs seconded Cllr Tritton – all in favour. No vice chair elected. To review in 6 months.
02/18	MINUTES OF THE 2017 ANNUAL PARISH MEETING It was proposed by Cllr Samme, seconded by Cllr Matthews and resolved to accept the Minutes of Annual Parish Meeting held on 8th May 2017. These were signed by the Chairman as a true record.
03/18	CHAIRMANS REPORT Cllr Samme advised that during the last year the war memorial railings have been completed, and they were received very well by residents. A number of compliments were received. David Steed made a donation and thanks to him. The fence by The Leys has been fixed and new gate in the play area. Cllr Matthews and Cllr Dearing have removed 2 dead trees, and Cllr Samme thanked Cllr Matthews for his work on reseeding the grass in the dog area. The area is still closed and there have been a number of enquiries as to when it will be reopened. The parish council insurance does not cover us whilst we know the area is not fit, so it will remain closed.
